Welcome to INVESTOHIO! We are glad you can be with us for a day of equity presentations from Ohio public companies, engaging information and networking. What follows is important information you'll need in arranging your visit to INVESTOHIO and the Hilton Columbus at Easton.

Requesting one-on-one meetings with corporate management

Individual meetings can be requested with participating public companies up until 5 p.m. Wednesday, September 14. Meetings are restricted to analysts, institutional investors, fund managers and professional investors. To assure a potential meeting slot, you should make your request as early as possible.

The requests are evaluated by the companies, which make the final decision on the composition of and attendance at the meetings.

To request a meeting, visit www.invest-oh.com and click on “Returning Attendee Login” in the left margin. On the next screen, enter the User Name and Password you established at initial registration.

A menu of options will appear. Click on the “*I-on-1 Requests*” tab. Click on the public companies with which you’d like to meet. DO NOT SELECT MORE THAN SEVEN COMPANIES, as the day’s schedule allows for a total of seven meeting slots during the day.

Prioritize your list by clicking on the *I-on-1 Rankings* tab.

Dress code

Business Casual is appropriate for the conference.

Parking

Sufficient parking is available both in the surface lots and in an adjacent parking garage.

Attendee check-in/credentials

If entering from the main lobby, check-in and credentials are to your left and down the hall into the conference facility. From the adjacent parking garage, check-in and credentials will be immediately on the right in the concourse. Check-in begins at 7:30 a.m. Pick up your name badge, a conference tote bag for carrying materials, and any last-minute one-on-one meeting instructions. Your name badge is necessary for the day's proceedings. Proceed to the Easton Grand Ballroom (A-B) on the left, where continental breakfast is being served. The conference opening, as well as the lunchtime keynote speech, takes place in that room.
